It said that many people loved that spot because there were a lot of big fish. He also saw some photos in the article of smiling people who caught very big fish. So, he decided to go.

Mr. Shima woke up at 4:30 a.m., washed his face quickly, jumped into his favorite sports car, and drove to the fishing spot. It was a long drive but he liked driving. He enjoyed listening to the music and feeling the fresh morning air while in his car. It was a good time for him. There were few people fishing there. He was happy because it was a very quiet place. When he walked along the lakeside to find a place to fish, he saw a boy fishing alone. The boy looked about ten years old. Mr. Shima spoke to him. “Hi, are you alone?” The boy turned to him and said, “Yes. My house is just over there.” “Oh, I see. Did you catch any fish today?” asked Mr. Shima. “I’ve already caught fifty,” the boy answered. Mr. Shima was surprised and said, “Fifty! That’s unbelievable!” The boy smiled, showed him a lot of fish and said, “My grandpa taught me how to fish. He is my fishing teacher!” “Would you be my fishing teacher? What is your name?” asked Mr. Shima. The boy looked surprised, but answered, “Yes. I’m Sanpei. Come here. Sit down next to me.”

Sanpei knew more about fishing than Mr. Shima. Sanpei gave a lot of advice to Mr. Shima. “No, no, don’t move yet!” he said. “You have to wait longer, Shima-san. *Timing is the most important thing in fishing. You have to think carefully and move quickly!” Mr. Shima laughed and said to him, “Sanpei-kun, I always say that to the young workers in my company!” Mr. Shima learned a lot of fishing *techniques from this young *teacher*, and was able to catch many fish. “Yes!
